

How to set up Optimal Seating

The floor-seating plan below allows every child to have a better view of the performer. Not only is it quieter than using chairs, but children are also closer to the performer which enhances connection with the kids and the magic of the show!

Need to know...

- ✓ We bring our own sound system, microphone and 15' (5m) extension cord, but we do need access to a power outlet. Please provide an extra extension cord if outlet is not close to the table set-up.
- ✓ Up to 600 students can be seated camp-style for a single show. It is important that the students are seated on the floor (especially if no stage is available).
- ✓ If the performance area is a stage, the performer needs an easy way to walk off center stage into the audience to interact with the students. Steps work well, preferably without a railing that could block their view.
- ✓ We understand that not all facilities can accommodate this type of seating arrangement. Please call your Account Executive for alternative effective seating suggestions.

Please have the performance area cleared and two 6' (2m) tables and a chair set up at least one hour before the show.
