PERFORMER

NED: "Whoa!" (optional "Oh, there's more...")

To finish your mission, just follow this tip...

What's that? In the sky? Look out! A spaceship!!!

All of a sudden, NED saw a spaceship coming right towards him.

And it looked like a giant brain.

Ned was so scared, he was shaking in his boots.

Just then, a tractor beam came down and pulled NED up into the Spaceship... and then NED was taken to their leader.

And the Alien Leader looked down at NED and said, "Welcome NED. We need your help... with our spaceship."

NED said, (Relieved) "Oh. OK. Wow, your spaceship looks like a

giant brain.”

The Alien said, “I know!” and the moment they said “I know”, the spaceship’s engine sputtered a little bit.

PERFORMER makes sputtering SFX
with physicality.

ALIEN: “NED, we love the human brain. But we don’t understand how it works.”

And NED said, “Oh okay... Well, we learned about the brain in school. A brain runs on learning...”

The Alien said, “I know!” And then the engine stopped.

PERFORMER makes engine failing SFX
with physicality.

NED said, “Excuse me... But it seems like when you say ‘I know’, something goes wrong. Wait a minute! When I was on the mountain, I said, ‘I know’ how to Never Give Up” but then I learned about the power of YET. When I was on the island, I said ‘I know’ how to Encourage Others but then I learned that I’m helping them shine because they’re a treasure. (thinking) Do... your... Best... Maybe, to do your BEST, you have to let go of ‘I know’ so you can LEARN and GROW.’

“I’ve got it! Take me to your engine room.”

And the engine looked like this.
